HMDA – DEDICATED BUS TERMINAL PROPOSED AT MIAPUR

A dedicated Bus Terminal particularly for private route buses is proposed to be developed in an area of 55.00 Acres at Miapur by HMDA at an estimated cost of Rs.100 Crores under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode jointly with IL&FS Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. This will be a model Bus Terminus with all facilities which includes budget hotel for drivers and staff, dormitories food courts, primary health centers, administrative offices, parking facilities for all types of vehicles, petrol bunks service stations and cargo facility.

The Objective is to develop a 'One Stop Shop' facility for having efficient 'Bus Terminal Services' at Miyapur, Hyderabad; Aimed at providing traffic solutions by reducing traffic congestions, by streamlining bus transit systems and by providing parking facilities to private and public buses at Miyapur, Hyderabad; Address the concerns of key stakeholders viz. Passengers, Local Commuters, Bus Operators, etc.

This project will be launched within (3) months and expected to be completed within one year.
