

**Minutes of the 15<sup>th</sup> Lake Protection Committee Meeting held on  
28.10.2016 at 2.00 P.M. in the Conference Hall of BPP Office, HMDA  
Tank Bund Road, Hyderabad**

- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and the Chairman, Lake Protection Committee (LPC) chaired the 15th LPC meeting and welcomed all the members.
  
- Further all the members were informed that the list of Lakes compiled Village/Mandal/District wise along with the lake ID number of each lake is placed in the HMDA website for information of the public and the same data shall be shared by the departments concerned to respond for further course of action.
  
- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA has briefed the members about the Hon'ble High Court Orders dated 11.07.2016 in Writ Petition Nos. 24260 of 2008, 30067 of 2011, 13215, 3705 and 12540 of 2012, 4362 and 8303 of 2013, 11499 of 2015 and PIL No. 254 of 2012 wherein it is ordered to conduct survey of all lakes / tanks / lands within the limits of GHMC to determine FTL after issuing the notice to the petitioners or any other person/ persons who claims that their lands are within FTL and then proceed to put up fencing covering the FTL, and then take action for removal of encroachments, if any FTL area of the Lakes. The Hon'ble High Court also directed GHMC, HMDA, Irrigation and Revenue Department to complete the said exercise on or before 31.12.2016. Further, it is also ordered that HMDA shall act as Nodal Authority for giving effect to the above order.

**(Action: GHMC, HMDA, Irrigation and Revenue Departments)**

- M/s Aarvee Associates, Consultant explained about the progress of FTL demarcation of Lakes. The Consultant has informed that survey of 2009 lakes has been completed out of total 3132 (2875+275 newly identified Lakes) and for conducting survey in respect of the balance 1123 Lakes, the assistance of Irrigation Department is immediately required to locate the FTLs of the lakes, since the existing features like bunds, weirs, sluice valves etc., are either destroyed or ruined.

**(Action: Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation)**

- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has invited attention of the members to the Minutes of the Meeting of the Chief Secretary to Government, Telangana State held on 30.03.2016, to review the activities of the LPC, wherein the time lines for certification of pending FTL Maps were fixed, which has already expired. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has requested the Collectors to sort out inter departmental issues with Revenue and Irrigation officials and expedite the survey work, verification and certification of Lakes for final notification so that the lakes / tanks can be safeguarded from any encroachments / pollution. It is also instructed that the Irrigation officials at field level have to coordinate with the Consultants for completing the survey work of the balance lakes expeditiously and ensure that final notification of the identified lakes are completed by 31.03.2017.

**(Action: Collectors of concerned Districts in HMA area and Irrigation Department),**

- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has instructed the Superintending Engineer, North Tank Division, GHMC for completion of fencing of FTL around the lakes to avoid further encroachments in the GHMC Jurisdiction and take necessary action for removal of encroachments.

**(Action: GHMC)**

- The Director-II, Planning, HMDA has informed that as per the QC works 4148 Tanks / Lakes were identified in the HMA area. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has instructed for reconciliation of number of Tanks and Lakes, in coordination with Irrigation Department and EPTRI for finalization of the number of Lakes for incorporation in the Master Plan.

**(Action: Irrigation and EPTRI)**

- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has requested the EPTRI for conducting study on the functioning of the STPs constructed so far and suggesting measures to be taken for improvement and proper functioning of STPs. Further it is also suggested for constitution of a Committee to oversee the functioning of the STPs. The EPTRI is requested to submit a proposal in this regard.

**(Action: EPTRI, HMDA)**

- It is brought to the notice of the Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC by the Superintending Engineer, HMDA that certification of 926 Lakes by Irrigation Department and 498 Lakes by Revenue Department is pending as such the issue of final notification of the FTL maps is held up. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA has instructed Irrigation & Revenue Officials to expedite verification and certification of Lakes in order to achieve the targets by 31.12.2016.

**(Action: Collectors of concerned Districts in HMA area and Irrigation Department)**

- The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC has also instructed to take necessary action for removal of encroachments within FTL area of Ameenpur Lake and initiate criminal action against the culprits in coordination with Police Department.

**(Action: Collector, Sanga Reddy District and Police Department)**

- The Sr. Environmental Scientist has informed that TSPCB is monitoring the Pollution levels of 25 Lakes regularly and updating the data in particular of Hussain Sagar Lake and the data shall be sent to the Convener, LPC through E-mail on regular basis. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC requested TSPCB to take necessary steps to curb the sewage water/Industrial effluents from entering into the Lakes/Nalas.

**(Action: TSPCB)**

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks to all the members and requested to take necessary action by all the departments concerned for completion of the FTL demarcation and Cadastral Mapping for notification and placing on the website for public domain so that the information of the water spread area is available to everybody and the lakes are protected from the encroachments.
