

**Minutes of the 11<sup>th</sup> Lake Protection Committee Meeting held  
on 17.03.2015 at 3.30 p.m. in the Conference Hall of  
BPP Office, Tank Bund Road, Hyderabad.**

The 11<sup>th</sup> LPC meeting was chaired by the Member Environment, HMDA and Convenor, LPC. The Officers attended the meeting is enclosed as Annexure.

At the outset, the Member Environment and Convenor, LPC has welcomed all the members and explained about the agenda items and made a presentation on the activities being taken up by the LPC and progress of the FTL Demarcation, action taken on the representations forwarded by the LPC. Status of court cases and proposals under adopt a lake scheme and remarks of the Audit.

After detailed discussions on the agenda items, the following decisions were taken:

As it was only a introductory meeting, ( as most of the officers are new ) all the members were requested to send the Action taken reports on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> LPC meeting decisions by next meeting.

All the members were informed that the list of lakes compiled Village/Mandal/District wise and with Lake ID number is placed in the HMDA website for information of the public and officers. A Demonstration on the query based lake information is also given which will be available to all LPC members soon.

As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble Lokayukta, identification and demarcation of FTL of the lakes has to be submitted for 521 lakes in erst while HUDA area, as early as possible.

It was emphasised on the demarcation of the FTL by the Consultancy i.e., M/s Aarvee Consultancy., as reported by the Executive Engineer, L & P, HMDA. Till now (438) lakes were certified by the Irrigation Department and preliminary notification issued by HMDA which were also uploaded in the HMDA website., and (29) Balance lakes have to be completed in GHMC area and 54 lakes in HMDA area., The balance of the FTL demarcation is as follows:

All the above officers were requested to complete the certification of the lake maps pending with them by the next meeting

The Collectors were requested to complete the verification of the FTL maps with that of Revenue Maps and certify them for publication of final Notification and a report has to be submitted to the Hon'ble Lokayukta.

The Collector, Ranga Reddy has submitted information of (8) Mandals out of (14) Mandals, The information furnished is also partial and incomplete. The Collector, RR District was requested to send the lake maps of the remaining lakes by next meeting, for which the Joint Collector, RR has agreed. The Jt.Collector, Hyderabad has furnished (10) lakes maps, out of (23) maps, He was also requested to send the remaining lake maps.

Then the discussion was held on audit paras and all the members of the LPC were requested to take action on the remarks posed by the Audit under intimation to Lake Protection Committee.

The Lake Protection Cell has received many Representations / Complaints from public/organisations. The EE lakes and Parks Division & DSP, Enforcement Cell along with addressed agency (Technical Committee) to inspect the representations and complaints requests and submit reports. (Total representations **50** Adoption requests **33**)

**(Action: Technical Committee of HMDA)**

All the members were requested to bestow their personal interest on the all kinds of court cases and requested them to furnish the replies under intimation to the Lake Protection Committee.

The Joint Collector, Ranga Reddy has raised a point that as to who is the owner of the tanks and who has to report on encroachment. However he promised to extend the cooperation, men and material for eviction of the encroachments. A lengthy discussion was held on this and suggestion has come that the Lake Protection & Development authority may be constituted on the lines of one in Bangalore.

Regarding the pollution monitoring in lakes the HMWSSB & TSPCB may work together to make the plans for the pollution control & Sewerage management, in the lakes of Hyderabad Metropolitan region more particularly for tanks within ORR.

**(Action: TSPCB & HMWSSB)**

HMWSSB also requested to submit the comprehensive plans finalised by them with regard to Himayath Sagar & Osman Sagar Catchment protection.

**(Action: HMWS & SB)**

It is informed that 42 no. of Home Guards services are provided by police department for lake protection on payment basis. Regarding engaging the Home guards for lake protection the DIG (L&O) clarified that renewal once made it will be in force for 3 years. Therefore advised HMDA to check the agreement.
