

Minutes of the 12th Lake Protection Committee Meeting held on 05.10.2015 at 3.00 P.M. in the Conference Hall of BPP Office, Tank Bund Road, Hyderabad.

The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and the Chairman, Lake Protection Committee (LPC) chaired the 12th LPC meeting.

At the outset, the Director, Urban Forestry, HMDA and the Convenor, LPC has welcomed all the members and explained in detail about the agenda items.

Further, all the members were informed that the list of lakes compiled Village / Mandal / District wise along with Lake ID number of each lake is placed in the HMDA website for information of the public and the same data shall be shared by the officers concerned to respond for further course of action.

M/s Aarvee Associates, Consultant of the HMDA has made a detailed presentation about the progress of FTL demarcation of lakes. During the presentation the consultant has informed that **under phase-2**, 1400 lakes survey has been completed out of total 2402 lakes and for conducting survey in respect of the balance 1000 lakes, the assistance of Irrigation Department is immediately required to locate the FTLs of the lakes, since the existing features like bunds, weirs, sluice valves etc., are either destroyed or ruined.

Under phase-1, 14 lakes in the GHMC area are not yet to be completed due to stoppage / resistance by local residents and also not permitted by the Defence Authorities for the lakes falls under their area.

In this regard, the Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA and Chairman, LPC requested the Chief Engineer (Minor Irrigation) to expedite the above said work by deputing the concerned EEs' for coordinating with the Executive Engineer, Lakes Division, HMDA and the Consultant so as to complete the task in month.

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Lokayuktha, the MC, HMDA & Chairman, LPC has further requested the Chief Engineer (Minor Irrigation) for completion of the identification, demarcation, FTL of the remaining 83 lakes out of 521 lakes of **Phase-I** so as to enable the HMDA to complete the issue of Preliminary Notification within 15 days.

The Director, UF, & Convenor, LPC has informed the Revenue Officials of District Collectors, from Ranga Reddy Dist., Hyderabad Dist., and Medak Dist., that LPC has already requested for the verification reports of the Revenue survey numbers falling in FTL / Buffer areas of lakes vide letter no. 613/LPC/HMDA/ 2013, dt. 26.09.2015, for which the replies was not received so far for the phase-I. As such to issue of final notification of the FTL maps of the lakes was held up. The details of district wise pending issues in the matter are as follows:

The Lake Protection Cell received 50 No's representations/complaints from Public/Organisations and the same were forwarded to the concerned Executive Engineers, Irrigation Dept. and also addressed the concerned District Collectors to examine and take appropriate action at their jurisdiction on the said representations with intimation to the LPC.

In this regard the M.C., HMDA & Chairman, LPC requested the concerned officials to expedite the action in the matter so as to report to Hon'ble Lokayuktha.

Sr. Env. Scientist, TSPCB has informed that TSPCB has monitoring the pollution levels of 25 lakes regularly and updating the data.

In this regard the M.C., HMDA and Chairman, LPC, requested the concerned to give top priority in monitoring of Pollution Control & Sewerage Management of Himayathsagar and Osmansagar lakes.

Further it was requested to monitor the Pollution levels of Hussain Sagar lake duly taking the data from HMDA regarding daily Sewage Management of 30 MLD at Picket nala and also consider the sewage disposal of GHMC, and the data shall be sent to Convenor, LPC through e-mail on regular basis.

(Action: TSPCB)

The Executive Engineer (NTD), GHMC and the Sr. Scientist, TSPCB were requested to monitor not to dump the solid waste near the Herbal garden which leads to pollute the treated water of picket nala for which the purpose of the 30 MLD STP constructed by the HMDA is being affected.

Further, DRO, Hyderabad was requested to verify the ownership of the land in which development of Eco Park is to complete duly utilizing the JICA funds. Accordingly the Executive Engineer (HCIP) was instructed to furnish the Detailed Project Report (DPR) of Patigadda to the concerned DRO for taking further necessary action.
